- Attending a minimum of 6 weekly CLNM meetings
- Attending a CLNM residential
- Planning, delivering, attending (and being involved in elements of presenting) at the CLNM conference
- Attending LHP group sessions to ensure information is shared between CLNM and your LHP
- Completing peer evaluation training, fieldwork and delivering of key messages as a result of the evaluation
- Completing Peer Evaluations of Local House Projects and supporting the implementation of these recommendations
- Contributing to The National House Project Board of Trustees meetings

- Supporting young people to fairly identify representatives to join CLNM
- Providing funding for representatives to travel to CLNM meetings, residential(s) and conference(s).
- Enabling regular opportunities for young people from across all cohorts to provide feedback, thoughts and ideas to their CLNM representatives.
- Working with CLNM to continually develop House Projects for your young people.
- Listening and reflecting on feedback from young people to continually develop and shape best practice.
- Attending a CLNM safety planning meeting

## THE NATIONAL HOUSE PROJECT COMMITTS TO:

- Providing a venue and facilities to enable meetings, residential(s) and conference(s) to take place.
- Funding CLNM meetings and residentials for all representatives and an annual event for young people.
- Consulting with representatives to shape best practice.
- Providing opportunities for representatives to be involved in writing policies and ensure CLNM representation at Board Meetings so their views inform decisions.
- Attending a CLNM safety planning meeting
